

CEDAR PARK TYPHOONS STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

In addition to abiding by the NWSC Code of Conduct, all members are also expected to adhere to the Cedar Park Typhoons Standards of Conduct.

The Cedar Park Typhoons are committed to the principles of ethical behavior. In order to promote a positive experience for all members, we expect all swimmers, parents, volunteers, Board members and Coaches to adhere to seven basic standards of conduct:

1. Exercise self-control, self-respect, and self-discipline. No trash-talking, obscene or profane language in any form will be tolerated by anyone in attendance at a Typhoon event. Appropriate attire to be worn by volunteers and parents at swim meets and practices.
2. Demonstrate a positive attitude. Always employ good sportsmanlike behavior. No bullying or engaging in verbal altercations with any official, swimmer, coach or spectator on or off the pool area.
3. Respect the rights and feelings of others. Absolutely no physically violent behavior will be tolerated by anyone. Parents and swimmers are expected to be respectful of personal space.
4. Respect others' property. Absolutely no destruction of property allowed.
5. Support the training process.
6. Adhere to rules.
7. Promote a safe environment.

Violations of Cedar Park Typhoons Standards of Conduct will be subject to review by the Cedar Park Typhoon NWSC Board, and may result in seasonal or permanent ban of the violator and/or family from the Northwest Swim Circuit. Severity of the penalty will reflect the nature of the violation and decisions made by the Cedar Park Typhoons Board are final.
